




SPECTATOR SAFETY INFORMATION

- We have tried to ensure that you will be able to reach your chosen spectator viewing area without walking on the special stage. All the competitors will be travelling at high speeds and spectators **MUST NOT** walk on the stage route.
- All spectators are reminded that motorsport can be dangerous and despite us taking all reasonable precautions, unavoidable accidents can happen. In respect of these, you are present at your own risk. We ask that you obey all official and marshals' instructions in relation to your safety and that of others.
- Marshals will warn of approaching cars by use of a whistle, please take this as a final signal to ensure you are stood in a safe place and concentrating on the action.
- Children and infants should **ALWAYS** be accompanied by an adequate number of adults at all times who are responsible for their behaviour and safety.
- Stav above the track (never below).
- Do no stand in the straight-on position you will be removed.
- Respect the signs and the tape; Yellow and Black is GOOD i.e., it is ok to stand behind this tape, Red and White = a NO GO area, prohibited area MEANS prohibited for all.
- Listen to the marshals they are there to help you and ensure the event runs within the safety guidelines prescribed by Motorsport UK, the governing body of UK Motor Sport.
- If you do not abide by the instructions of marshals and event officials, the stage may be stopped or cancelled.
- Do not drive through any barriers left in the down position, whether locked or not, they are there for your own and others' safety.
- Do not enter or interfere with any of the Training Area buildings, installations or equipment, or touch any military equipment or debris. IT MAY EXPLODE AND KILL YOU!

Marshals and officials have the right to work without being abused or threatened. PLEASE TAKE ALL LITTER HOME WITH YOU. Consider your own safety and that of others at all times.






